FINANCIAL AND INSURANCE SURVEY: This type of report shall be understood to be a condition and valuation survey of the vessel for marine risk only. It informs the insurance underwriter and financial institution of the type and construction of the vessel, equipment and machinery. Items that comply and do not comply with the majority of accepted NFPA-302, ABYC, U.S. Coast Guard, and Insurance Underwriters standards or requirements are listed. The vessel is dry-docked for bottom inspection as required, fully inspected where accessible, and remarks are noted. Engines and other devices are started when possible to assure operation. Estimated fair market and replacement values are developed and a current photo supplied. This type of survey is not intended, nor should it be construed, to be a thorough buyer's pre-purchase condition survey.

The Client agrees to cooperate with the Surveyor in the performance of the survey, and that he or she has obtained the vessel owner's permission for the boarding of the vessel. The Marine Surveyor in turn agrees to perform the vessel survey to the best of his ability.

The Client understands that the survey report shall describe the condition of the vessel as observed through visual, audible, and other means as required, by the Marine Surveyor at the time his survey is conducted, and will contain unbiased opinions or judgments of the Marine Surveyor based on his skill, experience, and training as a Marine Surveyor. This survey will not involve the opening or removal of sheathing, joiner work, panelings, deck coverings, and/or the disassembly of machinery, plumbing, wiring or other components of this vessel. It is further agreed that the marine survey performed, and the report of marine survey issued, in no way constitutes a warranty or guarantee either expressed or implied of the condition of the vessel.

The Client understands that the Marine Surveyor accepts no responsibility for omissions based on information that has not been brought to, or has been withheld from his attention, nor for errors based on information not normally discoverable while acting with due diligence, nor for any conditions that may arise from said errors or omissions. The report of marine survey issued is subject to the understanding and agreement that the Marine Surveyor, and his company shall in no event be liable for consequential, personal, property loss or punitive damages and the legal liability of the named shall not exceed the fee paid by the requesting party for the survey and report regardless of claims or suits. The Client agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold the Surveyor harmless for any dispute, claim, cause of action or other controversy that may arise from the misuse of the Surveyor's comments or the survey report.

It is agreed and understood that the Client, by the execution of this agreement, obligates himself or herself for the payment of the marine surveying or consulting services performed, based on the estimated amount of the fee agreed upon herein, either prior to commencement of the survey inspection, completion of same, or upon completion of the survey report. Actual fees may vary based on circumstances surrounding the survey and actual reimbursable costs. Should the Client wish to forego the completion of a written survey report, payment shall be made for the Surveyor's time spent during, and preparing for the survey inspection at the current hourly rate specified.

In the event the Client fails to make said payment, he or she accepts liability to the Marine Surveyor for all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Marine Surveyor in the collection of said debt, and that use of the survey report will be considered theft. Furthermore, in the event that litigation becomes necessary, the Client agrees that Alaska courts shall be the proper legal forum and that the laws of Alaska shall apply.
